During the month of April, there were 318 requests for 781 recipients for a total of 11,715 meals. Persons fed was up 6% from April 2015.

In May there were 327 requests for 762 recipients for a total of 11,430 meals. Persons fed was up 10% from May 2015.

Since our supplies of clothes and housewares are limited, please don't offer them to those who haven't requested them on their referrals.

FISH now partners with United Way to distribute fresh food to those in need on the third Thursday afternoon each month. Each organization provides volunteers and helps find sponsors. The food is provided by the Virginia Peninsula Foodbank and there is an administrative fee of \$250. Church and civic organizations sponsor the event (pay the \$250 and provide some volunteers). Sponsors have been identified through March 2017. Please determine if your church or civic organization would like to sponsor a month. Ninety-one households were served in May. FISH provided 12 volunteers. If all goes well, the Messmer Community Services Center auditorium will be used for the distribution starting in August.

The Closet Report: In April, 505 outfits were provided to 124 adults and 62



children. Housewares were provided to 44 in April. In April the total number of requests was down 5% from April, 2015. In May 1,026 outfits were provided to 208 adults and 145 children. Housewares were provided to 50 in May. The total number of requests in May was up 12% from May 2015. FISH is in need of boys and girls clothing and silverware.
