The board has approved and is spending \$25,000 to help other nonprofits who continue to feed the local community. House of Mercy, Salvation Army, and St. Olaf's have been the recipients of food purchased online by Holly Trotter. They have also received food purchased at Costco by Mike Motes, Holly, and Jill Holroyd. Several of us have also taken stock from our pantry to House of Mercy. This has been an incredible effort to help support these organizations. A portion of the food purchased for House of Mercy has been fresh produce purchased from local farmers.

We continue to support the mobile food pantry financially. In addition to this, we will be providing food to help feed 200 children this summer as a part of the Summer Feeding Program.
