THE PANTRY REPORT

During the month of December, 322 food requests were made, and 838 people were fed--an increase of 18% from December 2018. Enough food was provided for 15,084 meals.

In January, there were 368 food requests made for 964 people--a 7% increase from January 2019. 17,352 meals were provided.

THE CLOSET REPORT

In December, 352 people were clothed (192 adults and 160 children) for a total of 815 outfits. This was a 40% decrease from 2018. In January, 305 people (187 adults and 118 children) were clothed with 742 outfits. This was an 16% increase from 2019.
