## The Pantry Report:

During the month of February, there were 266 requests for 628 recipients for a total of 9,390 meals. Persons fed was down 13% from February 2016. In March there were 320 requests for 750 recipients for a total of 11,250 meals. Persons fed was up 3% from March, 2016.

**The Closet Report:** In February, 514 outfits were provided to 124 adults and 70 children.

Housewares were provided to 50 households in February. In February the total number of requests was down 15% from February, 2016. In March 641 outfits were provided to 157 adults and 83 children. Housewares were provided to 45 households in March. The total number of requests in March was up 1% from March 2016.
